Did you know Leaves are beneficial?

Leaves are falling and being removed from properties, but did you know they are a valuable resource in the landscape? They are a source of organic matter and can be mulched into lawns with mowers, used in planters, containers, and gardens as soil amendment, mulch or create compost. Mulching them into lawns can benefit the turf as well as the soil and could potentially even mitigate the need for additional fertilizer. The additional mulching can also help soil moisture and reduce weeds by creating a thin layer of mulch on the soil surface. Who knew that falling leaves had so many beneficial uses within the landscape? So, while they are messy, they also help add value to the lifespan of your landscape.

Wrapping Trees For Winter

Tree wrap is used to protect young, thin-barked trees during the winter months. Wrapping trees helps protect against sunscald and frost cracks, both of which are temperature related. Not all trees need to be wrapped. Species such as linden, maple, ginkgo, crabapple, and redbud will benefit from tree wrap. Trees with thick, corky bark, like bur oak, do not need to be wrapped.
